Commerce and Commercial Sales Representatives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All salaried or wage-earning, manual and non-manual occupations in the retail and wholesale industry and those who for other reasons are defined as commercial workers. • All commercial sales representatives. This excludes those who sell only services, such as insurance, and those who should be defined as wholesale sales persons.
Electricity	All workers employed in the generation and distribution of electricity.
Finance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All employees of banking and financial institutions. • All employees of life and non-life insurance institutions including insurance sale agents.
Gaming	All employees and workers in casinos and other gaming establishments.
Graphical	All graphical employees including those involved in packaging, paper converting and publishing, advertising (printing and publishing), electronic publishing, pre-press and pre-media (printing and publishing).
Hair and Beauty Care	All employees engaged in hair and beauty care treatments.
Industry, Business and Information Technology Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All salaried and non-manual occupations in the industry, business and information technology services sector. • Computer and related services, research and development, legal activities, accounting, auditing, market research, advertising (clerical), consultancy services, management services, engineering services and technical consultancy. • Salaried employees, i.e. clerical, administrative, technical and supervisory staff, including professionals and managers. • Engineers, research, scientific and technical professionals and employees.
Media, Entertainment, Arts and Sports	All employees of media, entertainment, arts and sports including those involved in advertising (audio-visual), amusement establishments, audio recording, audio-visual activities, cable, cinema distribution and exhibition, cultural institutions, exhibitions, film laboratories and tape reproduction, film production, mass media, multimedia, pre-media (audio visual), public relations, radio, sports, television and theatre.
Post and Logistics	All employees of postal and logistic services.
Property Maintenance and Security Services	All employees in cleaning, security, janitorial and other related services.
Social Insurance and Private Health Care	All employees of social insurance institutions and private health care establishments including hospitals and clinics.
Telecommunications	All employees of telecommunications and related services including those involved in the transmission and processing of messages and information in any form.
Temporary Work Agencies	All temporary work agency staff and workers on temporary assignments, which have been placed by a temporary work agency.
Tourism	All employees of travel agencies and tour operators.
Who are Professional and Managerial Staff?	<p>According to the "Compendium of Principles and Good Practices relating to the Employment of Professional Workers" adopted by the ILO Governing Body, a professional or managerial worker is a person:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) who has completed a higher level of education and vocational training or possesses recognized equivalent experience in a scientific, technical or administrative field; and b) who performs, as a salaried employee, functions of a predominantly intellectual character involving the exercise of a high degree of judgment and initiative and implying a relative high level of responsibility <p>The term should also cover any person who, in addition to possessing characteristics a) and b) above, has had delegated to him/her, by and under the general direction of his/her employer, responsibility for planning, managing, controlling and coordinating the activities of part of an undertaking or of an organization, with the corresponding authority over other persons.</p>
